The Youth Symphony of Southern Oregon has contributed to the success of Rogue Valley communities and it has contributed to the region's creative prosperity and vibrant arts environment. The season will feature works by Antonio Vivaldi, Gioachino Rossini, Dmitri Shostakovich and many others. During the concert season, the YSSO's two full orchestras - Youth Symphony (advanced) and Youth Orchestra (intermediate) - will play an array of masterworks, concerti, arrangements, film scores and chamber music. Musicians from throughout region and beyond will be selected to participate. This year also marks music director Cynthia Hutton's 25th season with the Youth Symphony of Southern Oregon.
